(prices will be updated in February) Private accommodation – Single room: +/- 200€ - Double room: +/- 150€ - T1 (kitchen, living and bedroom): 500€ <u>Meals:</u> Student restaurants – from 1,90€ to +/- 4,50€ (prices will be updated in February) <u>Books:</u> +/- 90€ <u>Local Transportation:</u> - 3 tickets: 1,90€ - 11 tickets: 6,00€ <u>Health Insurance:</u> it depends on the coverage
