



Paul Dalziel is Professor of Economics at Lincoln University, New Zealand. During his 25 years academic career in New Zealand, he has produced more than 150 research publications, including 43 publications listed in the American Economic Association's Econ-Lit database. Two of his four books on the New Zealand economy have been translated and published in Japan. He is Science Leader for the Foundation of Research, Science and Technology's five-year research programme "Education for Employment". His specialist areas of research are regional economic development, labour market policy and macroeconomics. He is a member of the Advisory Panel for Macroeconomic Forecasts of the New Zealand Treasury, a member of the Economics and Human Behaviour Marsden Fund Panel of the Royal Society of New Zealand, and is New Zealand Vice President of the Australia New Zealand Regional Science Association International.
