



## How are residents chosen?

Each year the demand to live @ UOW increases. The mission of Accommodation Services is to actively support UOW and the student experience by providing secure, supportive and sustainable communities. Accommodation Services values diversity, personal growth and academic success.

To achieve this, it is important that a diverse and balanced community is represented in the residences and includes a mix of domestic, international, early entry, study abroad and returning students. Accommodation Services takes into account a number of factors when making offers to students including the date of application, region or country of application, and consideration to returning and new applications.

Students are asked to make 4 preferences for accommodation. If you do not accept the offer of accommodation that is made to you, you will not receive any further offers of accommodation for Session 1, 2010. It is strongly advised that you accept any offer to live @ UOW immediately.

## Offers timeline for 2010

### Returning Students

Offers for all Returning students commence 1 November 2009. Some further returning offers may occur through early/mid December.  
*(Returning students are not guaranteed an offer).*

### Study Abroad Students / Exchange Students

Offers of accommodation will commence on 1 December 2009.

### Domestic Deferred / Early Entry Students / Direct Offers

Offers of accommodation will commence in mid December 2009.

### International Students

Offers of accommodation will commence on 1 December 2009.

### Domestic UAC 1<sup>st</sup> year students

Offers will be sent following the University offers – (UAC main round offers are released from 9pm, 20 January 2010).

It is important that you regularly check the email account that you nominated in your accommodation application. These offers are valid for seven days, after which time if the offer is not accepted and paid (\$500.00 rental prepayment fee) the offer will be lapsed/withdrawn. If you do not accept the offer, your 2010 application for accommodation will be cancelled/void.
