



In 2011 there are a range of other living options available to students which include:

- Living @ [Wollongong Surf Leisure Resort](#) (WSLR). WSLR is located in Towradgi and has convenient access to the University via the free Gong shuttle. It offers students fully self contained, open planned motel style units with kitchen and ensuite facilities. All linen is supplied and bedding is in an open plan unit consisting of 1 double bed and 1 set of single bunk beds. Maximum 2 persons per unit is permitted. WSLR is a commercial operation and is not managed by the University of Wollongong.

If you have already applied to live @ UOW, please contact [Alison Attenborough](#) to update your application or preferences to WSLR - there is no need to apply again. If you have not already applied please proceed to the [Online Application](#) through the UOW Accommodation Portal.

- Book temporary accommodation at Keiraview Accommodation for the first few weeks of arrival by emailing Keiraview@uow.edu.au. Please be sure to include your arrival dates and how long you would like to stay. The staff at Keiraview can help you with temporary arrangements.
- Temporary accommodation is available at **Ibis Wollongong**. Ibis Wollongong is conveniently located in the heart of the city just one block from the free 'gong' shuttle bus. Each room has a desk, tv, airconditioning, mini fridge and ensuite bathroom with toilet and shower. Fully equipped kitchens are available on each student level of accommodation. Asian and European supermarkets are within 500 metres of the hotel. To stay at the Ibis Wollongong students can book online at <http://www.independentstudentliving.net.au>.
- Consider private, rental or share accommodation in the Wollongong area. Accommodation Services offers housing assistance to students seeking rental accommodation. - Consider Rydges Hotel or WSLR for Session 1 and apply to live @ UOW for Session 2. This can be done by [applying](#) online via the Accommodation Services website for Session 1 + 2 and listing Rydges as the first preference for session 1.
