## **Admission to the Subject:**

To be eligible to apply for a place in HIST 265, applicants must meet the following minimum criteria:

- Currently enrolled in an undergraduate degree at the University of Wollongong.
- Have successfully completed 36 credit points, including 6 credit points in HIST, POL, AUST, ARTS or CENV.

## **All applicants please note:**

- HIST 265 includes a nine day tour to Istanbul and Gallipoli. You must be eligible to obtain a passport and a Turkish entry visa to participate. Payment of the tour fare will be required, in full, well in advance of departure.
- A quota applies to this subject. If applications for enrolment exceed the quota, students will be admitted based on the following criteria:
  1. Bachelor of Arts students
  2. History and/or Politics majors
  3. Completion of HIST 203, "Australians and the Great War"
  4. Evaluation of written statement
  5. Interview
  6. Please note that each satellite campus (Moss Vale, Shoalhaven, Bateman's Bay and Bega) will each be allocated a minimum of one position in the subject.
