# Subject Outlines

Subject Outlines are a standardised document that you receive at the outset of each subject. That contain information including:

- Assessment tasks and due dates
- Lecture and tutorial schedule
- Reading list by week
- Contact details of the subject coordinator and tutors

# Subject Readings

Each subject will come with a reading list. This is a selection of publications that will be used to teach the subject.

Types of Readings:

- **Books and Textbooks:** these can be purchased from the Unishop.
- **Subject Reader:** is a booklet containing a selection of excerpts, articles or other reading materials have been selected for the subject.
- **Articles:** generally available online through the library or a reader.

# Printing and Copying

Students are able to print from any shared computer on campus and use credit from their student card to release the job from any designated printer on campus.

Your student card comes loaded with \$5 worth of print/copy credit and you can either recharge your card with cash or online.
