



IMPORTANT CAMPUS NOTICE 2009 WEERONA COLLEGE STUDENTS

Advice has been received from Wollongong City Council concerning the railway underpass at Smith and Dension Streets.

Council understands the convenience of the underpass as a convenient short cut, but advise that students should not use this area at night.

Council advises that the underpass lacks intrinsic safety at night and there is no natural surveillance from

passing traffic or adjacent residences.

Council further advises that students should use the well-lit pathways along Thorsby Drive and Dension and Victoria Streets instead of the underpass.

In these areas, students have a greater opportunity to summon help and have the activity of passing vehicles that may deter opportunistic offenders.

Using the underpass at night, is not safe and students may not be able to summon help in this area particularly at night.

Students should further consider the appropriateness of using the railway underpass at all - even during the day. Consider using the more traffic-frequented route as mentioned above.
