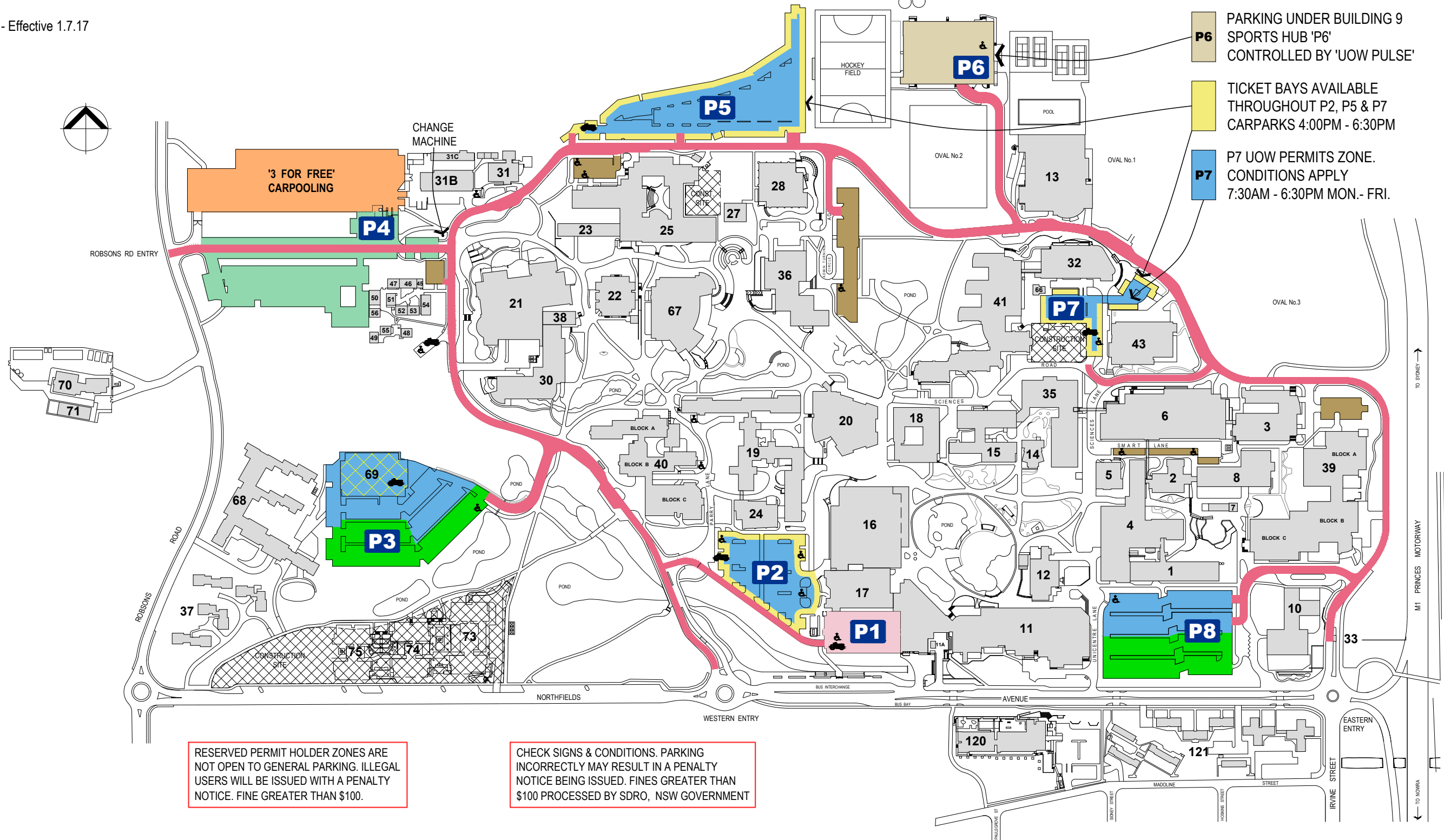


2017 WOLLONGONG CAMPUS PARKING

2017 PARKING – WOLLONGONG CAMPUS

Anticipate high demand for parking spaces at peak times – especially in the early weeks of session. Use the parking guidance signs and UOW Parking app to reduce time searching for limited parking in peak periods. Where practicable, to consider walking, cycling or using bus and train services to avoid this.

- Pay & Display ticket parking is restricted to signposted Pay & Display ticket bays in P3, P4 and P8 carparks. This parking is on a 'first-come first-served' basis. Purchase a Pay & Display ticket from one of the ticket machines and display it on the vehicle's dashboard, correct side up.
- There are two Short-term Parking Stations – the Multi-Storey Carpark (P1) and under the Sports Hub (P6). Parking in these Short-term Parking Stations is also on a 'first-come first-served' basis to staff, students and visitors.
- P2, part of P3, P5 and P7 are UOW entry permit carparks, and bays are restricted to permit holders only. An entry permit does not guarantee a parking space.

PARKING RATES

Rates are listed on the reverse side of this sheet and see uow.edu.au/parking for more detail. Parking at URAC's Sports Hub car park (P6) has a members' rate and a retail rate. Check out URAC's website for more details urac.com.au/aboutus/parking.

PARKING PENALTIES

Failure to display a ticket in ticket bays or display a valid permit in permit bays will result in a Penalty Notice being issued to the offending vehicle. Note: Tickets are not valid in UOW permit bays and UOW permits are not valid in ticket bays except where signposted. Failure to comply with signposted conditions will result in the issue of a Penalty Notice processed by the NSW State Debt Recovery Office.

CARPOOLING – “3 FOR FREE” PARKING

UOW encourages students and staff to carpool to share the cost of parking and petrol, and reduce environmental impacts. Parking is free in the P4 carpooling area for cars bringing three or more people to campus if you arrive between 7:30am and 5:45pm (3pm on Fridays)- see the Parking Attendant as you drive in. See uow.edu.au/transport/carpooling. Carpooling is also available for staff arriving with three or more people in a car in the Multi Storey Carpark (P1). Arrive between 8:00am and 3:30pm and show your staff ID to the Parking Attendant when you arrive.

ALTERNATIVES TO DRIVING

FREE SHUTTLE BUSES

Catch one of the **FREE shuttle bus services**:

- **Transport for NSW Gong Shuttle**– routes 55A (anticlockwise) and 55C (clockwise) connecting to Fairy Meadow, Innovation Campus, Weerona College, North Beach, the CBD, Wollongong Station, and the Hospital.
- **UOW North Gong (NG) Shuttle**- connects the Wollongong Campus with North Wollongong Station.
- **UOW Gwynneville- Keiraville (GK) Shuttle**– connects the Wollongong Campus with Keiraville, Gwynneville and Wollongong in both clockwise (GKC) and anticlockwise (GKA) loops.

TRAINS AND OTHER BUSES

For those coming from further afield why not Park and Ride from any train station to North Wollongong Station then use the **free North Gong Shuttle** to Wollongong Campus? Making the most of your travel time to study or catch up on work is easy with more than 100 train services running to and from North Wollongong Station every weekday.

WALKING AND CYCLING

With over 43% of students and staff living within 3km of UOW, students and staff are encouraged to consider green and healthier active transport options like walking and cycling.

- All paths on the campus are shared. Cyclists are reminded to take care and always give way to pedestrians. Regulations require a helmet to be worn when riding on and off campus, and have a white headlight and a rear red light if riding at night.
- Bike racks are located outside most buildings on campus. Secure undercover bike parking and end-of-trip facilities are available in Building 6 (SMART), Building 19 (Arts), Building 21 (Early Start), Building 32 (IHMRI) and Building 43 (Sciences Teaching Facility).
