Dean's Scholars Program

Bachelor of Commerce or Bachelor of Business Administration



These two special degrees provide an enriched educational experience for high-achieving students. Entry will be considered for applicants with a minimum UAI of 93 or equivalent. An interview may be required as part of the application process. Students will be required to maintain an average mark of 75 to continue in the program. Current Commerce students can apply for course transfer to the Dean's Scholars program after completion of a minimum of 48 credit points at the

University of Wollongong. (Entry based on academic record).



Dean's Scholars will complete all requirements for their respective degrees and may be permitted to take accelerated programs after their first session. Opportunities to attend workshops and seminars will be available, along with a 3-year, fully funded leadership development program.

This course is available for either the Bachelor of Business Administration or the Bachelor of Commerce as a single degree.

The degree is available at all campuses and includes a book allowance of \$500 per year (\$250 for part time). Students will need to fill in an application form available from UniAdvice on 1300 367 869 or on the web at: www.uow.edu.au/commerce/scholars.html.

ALL APPLICANTS

The program is open to single-degree students of the Bachelor of Commerce or Bachelor of Business Administration at all campuses. Students should nominate a degree and location for this application.

- If an interview is to be held, it will take place in December. Students will be notified of the result of the selection process following the release of the HSC results.
- Admission to the degree is by HSC result (or comparable results for non-HSC applicants) and application, and may include an interview. HSC students who achieve a UAI of 93 or above (or equivalent for non-HSC students) will be considered. There is a limited intake.
- If you wish to be considered, you must complete a UAC application nominating this degree as a preference AND submit this application form.

All students please note:

- The Dean's Scholars degree is not a scholarship. If you wish to apply for a University scholarship, please obtain an application from UniAdvice.
