## Honours Scholarship Program Conditions

<b>NAME OF SCHOLARSHIP:</b>	Faculty of Commerce Honours Scholarships
<b>DONOR:</b>	Faculty of Commerce
<b>ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA:</b>	<p>Candidates must be eligible for and enrol in the BCom (Hons). Candidates must have completed a major in one of the Faculty of Commerce disciplines and other requirements for the Bachelor of Commerce (or equivalent degree). Candidates may enrol in either a single discipline or joint disciplines.</p> <p>The selection committee will take into account the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>overall academic record (WAM),</li> <li>record in 300 level subjects in the relevant discipline(s),</li> <li>research potential of the candidate,</li> <li>leadership potential of the candidate,</li> <li>the discipline(s) the candidate plans to pursue in their honours program; normally, and if there are candidates of sufficient merit, there will be two scholarships awarded to students planning to study in each of the three Schools, Accounting &amp; Finance, Economics, and Management, &amp; Marketing, and</li> <li>an interview of the candidate may be required..</li> </ol> <p>Scholarships will be awarded only if there are candidates of sufficient merit. Applications will be called for in mid-year if any of the six scholarships are unfilled.</p>

<b>SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION</b>	<p>Please include with your application:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A copy of your academic transcript</li> <li>A statement (500 word maximum) that identifies the disciplines you plan to study, your reasons for doing Honours and your research and leadership potential.</li> <li>A statement (500 word maximum) outlining possible research area of interest.</li> </ol>
<b>SELECTION OF RECIPIENT:</b>	<p>The selection committee will consist of:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Director of Teaching &amp; Learning, Faculty of Commerce</li> <li>Heads of each of the following three Schools: Accounting &amp; Finance, Economics and Management &amp; Marketing.</li> </ol>



<b>NAME OF SCHOLARSHIP:</b>	Faculty of Commerce Honours Scholarships
<b>VALUE OF PRIZE/SCHOLARSHIP:</b>	There will be six scholarships each with a total value of \$3000. For full-time students a payment of \$1500 will be made when the student enrolls and another payment of \$1500 will be made as soon as feasible after the second session HECS census date. For part-time students a payment of \$750 will be made when the student enrolls and there will be subsequent payments of \$750 as soon as feasible after the HECS census dates for the second, third and fourth sessions of enrolment.
<b>TENURE OF SCHOLARSHIP:</b>	The scholarship will be for one year for full-time students and two years for part-time students.
<b>METHOD OF AWARD:</b>	Cheque
<b>CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP:</b>	Students must make satisfactory progress each semester; this is defined as performance at the equivalent of Honours Class II(1) or higher.
<b>FREQUENCY OF AWARD:</b>	Annual (biannual if any of the six scholarships are unfilled at mid-year)
<b>PRESENTATION:</b>	Faculty of Commerce Award Night
