NAME OF SCHOLARSHIP:	Faculty of Commerce Honours Scholarships
DONOR:	Faculty of Commerce
ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA:	<p>Candidates must be eligible for and enrol in the BCom (Hons). Candidates must have completed a major in one of the Faculty of Commerce disciplines and other requirements for the Bachelor of Commerce (or equivalent degree). Candidates may enrol in either a single discipline or joint disciplines.</p> <p>The selection committee will take into account the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> overall academic record (WAM), record in 300 level subjects in the relevant discipline(s), research potential of the candidate, leadership potential of the candidate, the discipline(s) the candidate plans to pursue in their honours program; normally, and if there are candidates of sufficient merit, there will be two scholarships awarded to students planning to study in each of the three Schools, Accounting & Finance, Economics, and Management, & Marketing, and an interview of the candidate may be required.. <p>Scholarships will be awarded only if there are candidates of sufficient merit. Applications will be called for in mid-year if any of the six scholarships are unfilled.</p>

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION	<p>Please include with your application:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A copy of your academic transcript A statement (500 word maximum) that identifies the disciplines you plan to study, your reasons for doing Honours and your research and leadership potential. A statement (500 word maximum) outlining possible research area of interest.

NAME OF SCHOLARSHIP:	Faculty of Commerce Honours Scholarships
VALUE OF PRIZE/SCHOLARSHIP:	There will be six scholarships each with a total value of \$3000. For full-time students a payment of \$1500 will be made when the student enrolls and another payment of \$1500 will be made as soon as feasible after the second session HECS census date. For part-time students a payment of \$750 will be made when the student enrolls and there will be subsequent payments of \$750 as soon as feasible after the HECS census dates for the second, third and fourth sessions of enrolment.
TENURE OF SCHOLARSHIP:	The scholarship will be for one year for full-time students and two years for part-time students.
METHOD OF AWARD:	Cheque
CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP:	Students must make satisfactory progress each semester; this is defined as performance at the equivalent of Honours Class II(1) or higher.
FREQUENCY OF AWARD:	Annual (biannual if any of the six scholarships are unfilled at mid-year)
