categories

Two Dimensional Art

Painting, drawing, print, montage, wall hanging, size not to exceed 2mx2m

Three Dimensional Art

Sculpture, montage, installation, jewellery, relief, textile arts.
Works must weigh less than 10kg & not exceed 2m x 2m x 2m.

Photography/Digital

Colour or black & white, including either digital or computer imagery. Entrants must have taken the photos/entries, but need not have developed or printed them. Size not to exceed 1mx1m

opening

Entrants are invited to attend a reception at the Long Gallery (Faculty of Creative Arts) at 12.30pm, Thursday 31st August. Prizes will be awarded at this opening.

Artworks and entry forms must be submitted to the Glass Room: 25.145 (Faculty of Creative Arts) Thursday 24 August and Friday 25 August between 12pm - 2pm only.

Artworks are to be collected from Room 25.103, 12pm - 2pm on Friday 22 September.

prizes

The winner in each category of 2D, 3D and Photo/Digital, will receive \$600. The runner up in 2D, 3D and Photo/Digital will receive a UniShop voucher of \$100.

conditions of entry

- 1 Entries are to be mounted, framed and fully prepared for hanging or display. Winning entries must be framed for acquisition (this is the responsibility of the artist).
- 2 Entries must be clearly labelled with the artists name, address, phone, title of work, medium and price.
- 3 A separate entry form is required for each entry.
- 4 All entrants must be currently enrolled students of the University of Wollongong - full-time, part-time, undergraduate or postgraduate.
- 5 Wollongong UniCentre is not liable for any damage to art works entered. Artists can be assured that all possible care is taken with art works.
- 6 Maximum of two entries per artist.
- 7 Submitted works must be the original work of the entering artist, completed within the last 2 years.
- 8 Art work must not have won a prize previously.
- 9 No collaborative works.
- 10 Art works must be available for exhibition between 25 August - 22 September 2006.
- 11 Art works must be collected on Friday 22 September 2006, between 12pm - 2pm from Room 25.103 (Gallery Store). Works will then be stored for a maximum of 4 weeks (after which time they will be disposed of). Collection by appointment with Didier Balez (FCA 25.G35b - 42 213790).
- 12 The judges decision is final. Wollongong UniCentre reserves the right not to make an award.
- 13 This is an acquisitive art award, which means winning works will be owned by UniCentre, and thus entries **must** be available for sale.
- 14 The maximum price for works should not exceed \$600 ie. entered work must not be valued at more than \$600.
- 15 If there is more than one winner in any one category then the prize will be divided.
- 16 Wollongong UniCentre reserves the right to reproduce images of entries in its publications and via its websites etc, for promotional purposes, including but not limited to: student diary, annual report, brochures, newsletters, website. All reproductions of winning artwork will acknowledge the artist, title of the work and year of acquisition.
- 17 Wollongong UniCentre reserves the right to reproduce photographs of all entries on the UniCentre websites, where they will be archived for 5 years, unless expressly requested in writing that you do not want your art work included in an archive of this event.
