The Poetics, Narratives and Mediums Discussion Seminars will examine the approaches within, and the intersections between, the disciplines in the Faculty of Creative Arts.

The aim of the seminars is to reflect on the nature of poetics, narratives and mediums and explore the relationships between them. Key questions asked are:

- - *What is a practising poetics?*
- - *What constitutes narrative? What are the strengths of and limits to narrative?*
- - *How do mediums operate and affect meaning?*
- - *How does theory and practice operate in different mediums?*
- - *Where are the points of overlap between these mediums?*
- - *How can mediums influence narrative and visa versa?*

The program includes staff members of the Faculty of Creative Arts, visiting artists-in-residence and recent graduates.

Each presentation will be followed by a general discussion.

All members of the Creative Arts and larger academic community are invited to attend.
