


## Uploading Your Photo (and using Photo Booth)

### Uploading your photo


From *Janison Desktop* (the first page after logging in) click on the *Upload your Photo* link towards the bottom of the navigation bar on the left. You will be presented with a page to upload your photo as illustrated below.

Select *Browse* to locate the file on your computer and finally click *Upload*.

You can upload any image (.jpg) file such as one taken with a digital camera or other source. Instructions for downloading photos from a digital camera are beyond the scope of this guide.

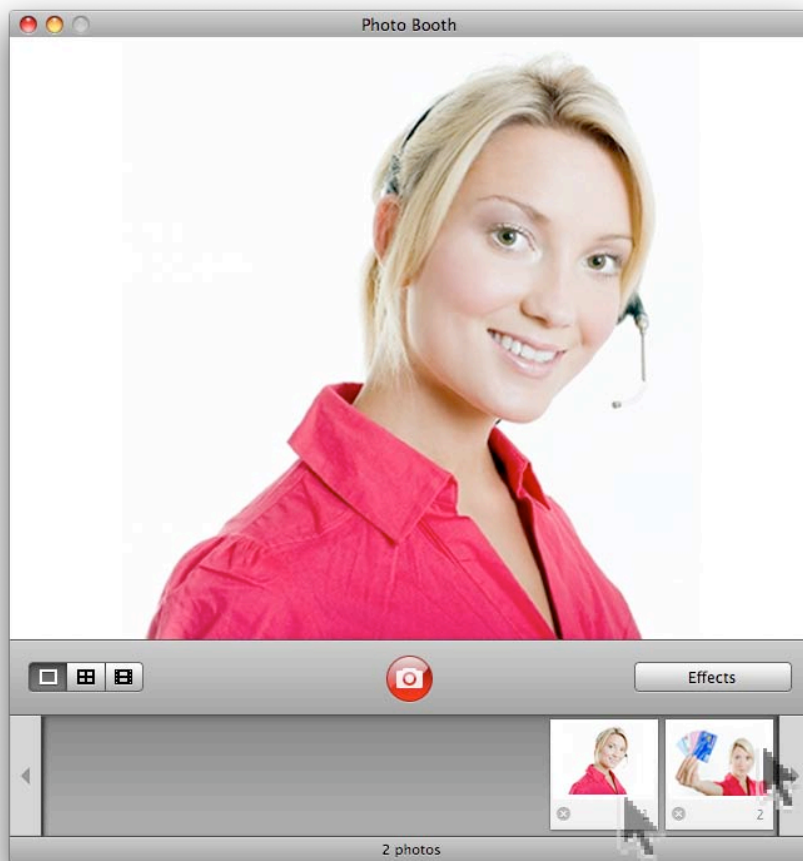

## Taking a photo with Photo Booth

Photo Booth is an application bundled with recent Macs and is available in the Faculty of Education's Interactive Multimedia Learning Laboratory.

To access Photo Booth open the *Applications* folder on the computer and double click *Photo Booth*.

Click the *red* button in the centre of the window to take the picture. Once you are happy with the photo drag and drop the photo from bottom area of the window onto the *desktop*. You can now follow the directions to upload the photo.
