

**Faculty of Engineering University of Wollongong****YEAR 12 2011 DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY HIGH SCHOOL COMPETITION****CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. The Competition is open to Year 12 High School Students who are studying Design & Technology.
 - Awards will be based on portfolios and products prepared by the Students.
 - The submissions must cover Engineering applications.
 - Each school will select the “best two” entries from its students. If one of these has not been prepared by a female, a third entry may be submitted. This entry will be considered for the Women in Design & Technology Awards.
 - If 1 of these 2/3 entries referred to above has not been prepared by an Indigenous student, a 3rd/4th entry may be submitted from an Indigenous student for consideration for the Woolyungah Indigenous Centre and Faculty of Education Indigenous Awards.
 - For single sex schools, a maximum of 3 entries can be submitted. The reason for the possible 4th entry from a co-educational school is to encourage women at these schools.
2. Each entry has to:
 - i. have been undertaken during the Year 12 Course i.e. October 2010 - September 2011.
 - ii. be prepared by the person entering the Competition.
 - iii. have the portfolio submitted as an “electronic” copy or a “hard” copy.
 - iv. not include large amounts of irrelevant material which is not reviewed, such as that sourced from the internet.
 - v. There is no maximum/minimum length requirement.

4. Entries must be submitted by no later than Friday, 17th September 2011.

Portfolio Content

- Accurate information relevant to Topic/Problem Statement.
- Structure of report including Aim, Method of Approach, Background.
- Relevant results including discussion of results.
- Creativity/Innovation.
- Quality of presentation.

Portfolio Presentation

- Grammar, Spelling and use of Formal Language.
- Quality of presented material.

Product Presentation

- The product will be judged on the work involved in its manufacture and how well it demonstrates the Engineering principles and processes in the solution of the problem being studied.
