

**Faculty of Engineering University of Wollongong****YEAR 11 2011 ENGINEERING STUDIES HIGH SCHOOL COMPETITION****CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. The Competition is open to Year 11 High School Students who are studying Engineering Studies.
  - Awards will be based on Engineering Reports prepared by the Students.
  - The submissions must cover Engineering applications.
  - Each school will select the “best two” entries from Reports for each Module submitted to them by students. If one of these Reports for each Module has not been written by a female, a third Report may be submitted. This Report will be considered for the BlueScope Steel Women in Engineering Award or the AECOM Women in Engineering Studies Awards.
  - If 1 of these 2/3 entries referred to above has not been prepared by an Indigenous student, a 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> entry may be submitted from an Indigenous student for consideration for the Woolyungah Indigenous Centre and Faculty of Education Indigenous Awards.
  - For single sex schools, a maximum of 3 entries per Module can be submitted. The reason for the possible 4<sup>th</sup> entry from a co-educational school is to encourage women at these schools.
2. Each Engineering Report has to:
  - i. have been undertaken during the Year 11 Course i.e. January 2011 - September 2011.
  - ii. be prepared by the person entering the Competition.
  - iii. have the Report submitted as an “electronic” copy or a “hard” copy.
  - iv. not include large amounts of irrelevant material which is not reviewed, such as that sourced from the internet.
  - v. There is no maximum/minimum length requirement.
3. In 2011, we are continuing with the online registration system. To access this system, please go to the Competitions’ website: <http://www.uow.edu.au/eng/highschoolcompetition/index.html> and click on the button ‘2011 Registration of Entry’.

For students who are submitting more than one Report in different Modules, you are required to complete a separate registration for each Report being entered. Each entry will have a unique registration number.

4. Entries must be submitted by no later than Friday, 17<sup>th</sup> September 2011.

**Content**

- Accurate information relevant to Topic/Problem Statement.
- Structure of report including Aim, Method of Approach, Background.
- Relevant results including discussion of results.
- Creativity/Innovation.
- Quality of presentation.

**Presentation**

- Grammar, Spelling and use of Formal Language.
- Quality of presented material.
