Terms of Reference

The Teaching Excellence Subcommittee shall:

2. Oversee and conduct the University's Outstanding Contribution to Teaching and Learning Awards.
3. Advise the DVC(A) on the University's Learning & Teaching (ULT) program and other teaching development activities.
4. Evaluate and advise the DVC (A) on proposals for the Education Strategic Development Fund (ESDF) grants.
5. Contribute to the University's engagement with external grants and awards for teaching excellence.
6. Identify and advise the DVC(A) on teaching and learning priorities and corresponding strategies.
