Who is this program for?

The Graduate Certificate/Master of Management program offered at UOW's Southern Sydney Campus has been designed to suit busy people who live or work in the Sutherland Shire.

It is perfect for those who have a lot of experience in business whose experience has outstripped their qualifications.

About the Programs

The Graduate Certificate/Master of Management is designed to provide an opportunity for practicing managers to enhance their career opportunities by developing further professional, personal and technical skills in key business areas.

The Graduate Certificate in Management is a one year part time program (4 subjects). SBS offers 2 subjects per quarter. In order to complete the Graduate Certificate in one year, you would need to choose one subject from the 2 on offer in each quarter. All subjects offered are business/management related.

The Master of Management program is a two year part time program (8 subjects). Those who enrol in the Graduate Certificate and successfully complete 4 subjects, can transfer to the Masters of Management and complete a further 4 subjects (8 subjects in total) to graduate with a Master of Management.

Students can commence their studies in any of the 4 intakes (February, April, June & September).

Each subject is taught on one evening per week (either a Wednesday or Thursday) from 6pm-9pm.



Subjects you can choose from:

Varies from year to year, but can include:

Managing People in Organisations; Innovation Topics and Cases; Corporate Governance; Introduction to Business Coaching; Accounting for Managers; Operations Management; Quality in Management; Economic Analysis of Business; Project Management; Marketing Management.

Advantages:

Your significant work experience + mature age could qualify you for entry into the Graduate Certificate.

Studying one subject at a time in short manageable chunks means that you can continue to focus on your work and family. It also means that you can complete subjects quickly (10 weeks).

You do not have to study in consecutive quarters – if work or other commitments come up, you can skip a quarter and then re-enter the program the following quarter.
