Criteria:

Applicants for the Graham, Bell & Bowman Scholarship for Medicine must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must be enrolled full-time in their second year of a Bachelor of Medicine/Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) in 2011. This includes students studying at either the Wollongong or Shoalhaven campuses.
- Applicants must demonstrate that they are in financial need.
- Applicants must demonstrate satisfactory academic performance including passing exams and performing satisfactorily in all assessments.
- Applicants must also demonstrate that they have made a positive contribution to academic or social activities in the School.
- Applicants must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident of Australia.

Interested students are encouraged to apply with the following:

- A completed Current Student Application Form from Student Central, Building 17 or from www.uow.edu.au/about/scholarships/currentforms/
- A completed Equity Scholarship Application Form, including authorisation for UOW to access Centrelink records to confirm your equity status
- A brief covering letter and résumé
- A copy of your academic transcript/s from previous studies
- An overview of your involvement in and contribution to the Graduate School of Medicine.
