**The University of Wollongong is globally ranked as one of Australia's best modern universities and is among the top 2% of universities in the world.**

The University of Wollongong is truly an international institution, with links to leading educational institutions around the world. The University has long-standing formal agreements with 272 institutions in over 40 countries and delivers transnational education programs in a number of locations.

The University of Wollongong's international reach spans off-shore campuses, research collaboration, student and staff exchange, study abroad and off-shore program delivery. Importantly the University's global network includes strong partnerships with key government agencies overseas as well as major international corporations to ensure our research is impact driven and commercially relevant.

The University of Wollongong has developed a strong offshore presence since the opening of the University's Dubai campus in 1993. The University also delivers tertiary education in Singapore, Hong Kong and Malaysia. Last year the University of Wollongong assumed stewardship and governance of the Community College of City University (CCCU) in Hong Kong, strengthening the University's position as a global higher education provider in North-East Asia.

### International recognition

The University of Wollongong is globally rated as a five-star university for its educational experience and graduate outcomes. Cultural diversity and the global mobility of our students and teaching staff are extremely important to the University and we continue to enhance our student and staff exchange and international scholarship programs.

The University of Wollongong has been recognised for its contribution to international education, winning the prestigious 2015 Hong Kong-Australia Business Association (NSW Chapter) Award, which recognises companies striving for excellence in international trade with Hong Kong. The University has also been awarded a Business Excellence Award for Education and Training in the 2015 AustCham Westpac Australia-China Business Awards.

The University of Wollongong has been named as one of the world's 'most international' universities according to the United Kingdom's Times Higher Education (THE). The University of Wollongong came 71 out of a full list of 200, indicating its success in attracting students and scholars from all over the world, fostering partnerships and collaborations with leading institutions as well as efforts to develop offshore education.
