

## **Vacancy for Community Members on Animal Ethics Committee**

The University of Wollongong is seeking to recruit community members to the Animal Ethics Committee. The Animal Ethics Committee reviews the ethical and scientific aspects of all animal research and teaching at the University. Project proposals range from cutting edge medical research to observation of native animal behaviour in the wild.

Applicants should possess an ability to communicate well, be comfortable using email and reading online, and have sufficient time to attend 8 meetings per year and read research proposals and other relevant documents. Committee meetings run for approximately three hours, lunch and afternoon tea are provided. Positions are voluntary; travel expenses can be reimbursed.

NSW regulations require that community members have not been employed by or otherwise associated with the university, or have been involved in the use of animals in scientific or teaching activities, either in their employment or beyond their undergraduate education.
