a. Senior Resident (Student Leader) at Graduate House (University Accommodation Service)

Jan 2007 – Current – University of Wollongong, AUSTRALIA.

1. I have been a student leader at Graduate House, University Accommodation Services at University of Wollongong since 2007 to present, resolving many issues concerning students from diverse backgrounds and culture. Other duties include:
2. Liaison between the students and university management
3. In-charge of postgraduate international students (with families) living in 78 units at Graduate House from diverse and cultural backgrounds
4. Be aware of health, safety and welfare issues and practices for students and university property
5. Beware of the chain-of-command in dealing with university management, university security, police, the public and students

b. Chairperson, Women Network Centre (WNC) Mombasa, KENYA from 2000 to 2003
