1 – Academic Culture at UOW

5 – Writing Great Paragraphs (2)

Week 8 – Friday 27 April 2012 12.30-1.30

In this workshop you will get feedback on your own writing and learn how to use evidence from your readings to make a convincing argument in your essays and reports.

6 – Editing Your Own Writing

Week 9 – Friday 4 May 2012 12.30-1.30

This workshop focuses on common mistakes writers tend to make in their work. It aims at helping you develop a sense of appropriate use of vocabulary. It also aims at developing an awareness of sentence structures suitable in academic writing.

7- Pronunciation (1)

Week 10 – Thursday 10 May 2012 12.30-1.30

This workshop is designed to help you speak more clearly and fluently when communicating with others in class, at work and at home. In this first week we will explore different aspects of pronunciation and you will record a short text for feedback from the lecturer
