



University Opens New Student Service Centre

The University "Student Service Centre" will open on Monday 20 May 2002. This centre will offer a range of services to students including accommodation services and student administration.

The Centre is located in Building 17 across from the Sal Paradise Cafe. It is positioned in a high "traffic" area to enable efficient access to students. The Centre will have:

- 3 computer terminals available to students to access their student record for viewing and undertake transactions eg subject variations etc
- full Accommodation Services and information (University managed accommodation and the current UniCentre service eg private rentals, job shop, payments etc);
- relevant student administrative forms and information;
- a computerised message board to provide relevant information to students for example enrolment times, various campus services etc will be implemented in the coming weeks.

The Accommodation Service Unit will be based at the Centre permanently. Student Administration are exploring the possibilities of staffing the Centre for student enquiries during peak periods and will be trialling this during the week after autumn semester results are released and the first two weeks of spring semester.

The Centre will give an additional service facility to students. We believe this Centre is a first for Australian Universities and are really looking forward to being able to provide students with an enhanced service.
