



Postgraduate Course Changes 2010 - Options

All the course changes and options described below apply to students commencing from 2010.

Currently enrolled students and those commencing in 2009 will not be affected, and will be permitted to remain in the existing courses, and course structures.

Type 1: Duration of existing 72cp course fixed at 1.5 years, with separate 2 year course option available

For the following courses, the existing 72cp programs will be retained as 1.5 year programs.

Students must complete 4 subjects (24cp) per session; there will no longer be an option to complete three subjects per session over two years.

Those requiring a 2-year program of study can enrol in programs shown in Option 2, below.

Type 2: Existing 72cp course replaced with a new 2-year (96cp) course or structure, with option to articulate from a 1-year course

In the following group of courses, the current 72cp program will be changed to either:

- 1) Increase the credit points in the same course to 96cp; or,
- 2) Create a new 96cp course

All courses require completion of four subjects per session; there will no longer be an option to complete three subjects per session over two years.

Students can either:

- 1) Receive upfront an offer for the revised/new 96cp course; or,
- 2) Receive a package combining an offer to a 1-year course with an offer into 2nd year of the revised/new course.

Type 3: Changes to Double Masters, Articulations and Selected 1 + 1 Options

In the course groups below, 84cp and 72cp programs have been replaced by packages which offer a full time study program of 4 subjects per session over every session.

In all cases, the same two-year study outcome can be reached by combining two 48cp Masters programs.

Master of Commerce Double Masters i.e. M Com followed by one of the following second Masters: Master of Applied Finance Master of Strategic Human Resource Management, etc.	These "Double Masters" programs will increase from 84cp to 96cp degrees as a 1+1 package. <i>NOTE: it will be still possible for students to articulate into the specialised masters from the M Com and complete the specialised masters with a further 6 subjects However, this may not meet the requirements for full-time study as defined by DIAC for Graduate Skilled Migration purposes. Articulation into the specialised masters with a further 8 subjects to complete is recommended as an alternative.</i>
Articulation into the Master of Business Administration (MBA) from an approved one-year (48cp) Masters course)	It will be still possible for students to articulate into the MBA from an approved Masters course, and complete the MBA with a further 6 subjects <i>However, this may not meet the requirements for full-time study as defined by DIAC for Graduate Skilled Migration purposes. Articulation into the MBA with a further 8 subjects to complete is recommended as an alternative.</i>
Master of Science (Population Health) this 72cp has been withdrawn; new two-year packages available	Master of Public Health (1 year - 48 cp) with the option to add a second one-year Masters as follows: MPH + Master of Health Leadership & Management MPH + Master of Health Informatics

Type 4: Other changes

COURSE	CHANGE
Master of Computer Studies	This course will increase from 72cp to 96cp
Master of Information Systems Advanced	This 72cp program will be withdrawn. The one-year Master of Information Systems is still available. Students seeking a 2-year program can enrol in the MICT Advanced, and major in Information Systems Development.
