2. A brief outline of your career ambitions and motivation in relation to your career path. Briefly explain why you have chosen to study at the University of Wollongong (maximum of one printed page).
3. Brief details of your major school activities, community involvement, leadership qualities and employment/work experience history (maximum of two printed pages).
4. Copies of school reports for year 12 (or equivalent) and trial HSC results (or equivalent).
5. Forward three complete copies of your application including attachments (i.e. One original and two photocopies). Each copy must be 'foldback clipped' (bulldog clipped) together. Please do not staple or place in folders with plastic sleeves or display books with plastic sleeves. Applications must contain only photocopies of original documents.

NOTE: Applicants are asked to provide only the information listed above.
