(The following minimum entry requirements should be used as a guide only and are subject to review at any time. Some courses may have additional entry criteria)

	<p>P = Portfolio of artwork (inc photographs/slides), written texts, musical compositions, or theatrical performance. Applicants need to meet both artistic entry requirements determined by an interview or audition and achieve the required weighted average mark. International applicants need to supply, as appropriate, a folio of artwork or musical/theatrical performances on certified VHS video format, which clearly identifies on screen the applicant's name.
