TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Acceptance of these terms and conditions

Submission of a signed application for the Scholarship is a deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.

2. Purpose

The Scholarship is designed to encourage the participation of all nations in the development and enhancement of sustainable solutions to global issues, such as the environment, world hunger and poverty, human rights, geopolitics, world trade and economic issues.

3. Types of Scholarships

There are three types of Scholarships:

- (a) *Education Australia Ltd Postgraduate Research* – the total value in 2010 will be AU\$25,000 per annum subject to satisfactory progress, available to international students wishing to undertake postgraduate research in Australia.
- (b) *Education Australia Ltd Study in Australia* – the total value in 2010 will be AU\$5,000 per annum, available to international students wishing to undertake study in Australia in either an Australian Study Abroad program or under an Australian university exchange agreement with an overseas university.
- (c) *Education Australia Ltd Study Overseas* – the total value in 2010 will be AU\$5,000 per annum, available to Australian students wishing to undertake overseas study in either an overseas Study Abroad program or under an Australian university exchange agreement with an overseas university.

4. Limit to number of applications submitted by universities

Universities are requested to submit applications for up to five Education Australia Limited Study in Australia or Study Overseas Scholarships per annum.

5. Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for the Scholarship, applicants must:

- Submit a completed application form
- Be nominated by an Australian university using the nomination materials provided
- Provide a report and a copy of academic results to Education Australia Limited at the conclusion of the Scholarship period (Study in Australia and Study Overseas Scholarships) or provide a report and a copy of academic results (if available). Report templates will be provided by Education Australia Limited.

6. Submission of applications

Applications must be submitted to Education Australia Limited via an Australian University.

7. Requirements

It is required that each recipient of the Scholarships (“**Recipient**”) must:

- Not defer their studies once commenced
- Not accept other cash scholarships without obtaining express permission from Education Australia Limited
- Diligently and to the best of their ability, apply themselves to their studies
- Comply with all university rules, regulations, by-laws, resolutions and other requirements
- Seek the written approval of Education Australia Limited in the event that, the Recipient wishes to defer, transfer, withdraw or discontinue the approved program or wishes to be absent for any reason for a period of 14 days or more from the place of study, such written approval is at all times at Education Australia Limited’s absolute discretion.

8. Award

Education Australia Limited will transfer the total value of the Scholarship to the host university to forward to the Recipient. The host university is solely responsible for any liability involved in transferring these funds to the Recipient.

9. Termination

A Scholarship is terminated if a Recipient:

- Ceases to meet the eligibility criteria
- Breaches the terms and conditions of the Scholarship
- Does not resume study at the conclusion of an approved leave
- Is guilty of serious academic misconduct.

If the Scholarship is terminated or suspended, Education Australia Limited will determine whether any refund of the Scholarship monies is payable and may determine that the Scholarship instalment for the semester in which the suspension or termination occurred be refunded by the Recipient to Education Australia Limited in part or in full.

10. Breach of Terms and Conditions

In the event that a Recipient fails to comply with any of the requirements set out in clause 7, Education Australia Limited reserves the right to require that

the Recipient repay, in part or in total, at Education Australia Limited's absolute discretion, monies paid to that Recipient by Education Australia Limited connected with the award of the Scholarship.

11. Promotion

Education Australia Limited reserves the right to arrange for the reproduction in any newspaper, magazine, film or other medium, details or images relating to or in connection with any award under the Scholarship to a Recipient.

12. Privacy

Any information supplied by an applicant is collected for the primary purpose of assessing eligibility to receive a Scholarship. Other purposes of collection include dealing with administrative matters relating to the application, corresponding with the applicant and the compilation of statistics.
