UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSIONS GUIDELINES – AUSTRALIAN UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION PROGRAMS

The following minimum entry requirements are a guide only – they do not guarantee admission to any individual course, and are subject to review at any time.

Grades shown are based on average academic subjects for UOW bachelor degree and academic subjects for WCA courses from:
 1. Western Australian Universities' Foundation Program (WAUFP). This is a joint project of the 4 public universities in WA ie UWA, Murdoch, Edith Cowan and Curtin. Grading: Combined Percentage Score (CPS) which is an average of the best 3 academic subjects, not including English Language & Australian Cultural Studies (ELACS) subject.

2. Monash University Foundation Year (MUFY). Grading: Percentage average of best four subjects (may include English)

3. University of NSW Foundation Studies Program. Grading: Grade Point Average as shown on transcript (maximum 10)

4. University of Sydney Foundation Studies Program. Grading: Grade Point Average as shown on transcript (maximum 10)

5. Queensland University of Technology Foundation Studies Program. Grade Point Average as shown on transcript (maximum 7.0)
