## Important Information

### Catering Arrangements

The fully catered residences (Weerona and International House) offer 19 meals per week served in a common Dining Room. The cost of this food service is included in the weekly rental fee.

\*\*The weekly rental fee at Campus East does not include the cost of food. Residents can purchase meals from the dining hall and from the on-site cafe, which is open throughout the day. There are limited catering facilities for those living in the flexi-catered units. These include a small communal kitchen, two BBQs, nearby supermarkets in Fairy Meadow shopping centre, a new hot meal vending machine, and microwaves.

At self-catered residences, residents prepare and cook their own meals in their studio, unit, or shared kitchen.

### Residential Fee Pre-Payment: \$500

This pre-payment is a non-refundable deposit which reserves your place in accommodation. The pre-payment is made through the accommodation portal at the time of accepting your offer of accommodation.
