Terms & Conditions

By submitting an application for In2Uni's University Preparation Program, I [the student and student's parent] declare that I have read the selection criteria provided on the UOW website and program brochure. I also hereby agree to abide by the University of Wollongong's [Code of Conduct](#), and the following terms and conditions:

1. Photography and Talent Release

The In2Uni Program occasionally uses photography and digital media for publicity purposes and showcasing the work of the students. I hereby consent for UOW and/or its representatives, agents and related entities to use any photographs or videos of my appearance, for possible inclusion in In2Uni's publications, websites and other publicity material. I understand that the image will remain the property of the University of Wollongong, and will be used for the designated purpose of promoting In2Uni's aims in relation to widening access to higher education.

2. Program Content and Supervision

I understand that as a participant of the In2Uni University Preparation Program I would be in an adult learning environment, and consequently, content will be delivered at a university level.

I understand that I will be responsible for organising my own transport to and from the campus. I understand that any costs associated with travel are not included in the program sponsorship provided by UOW.

3. Distribution of personal information

As an applicant of the University Preparation Program, I provide permission for the In2Uni Program to discuss my eligibility and course progress with staff at my respective high school, as required. I understand that I can authorise my parents to receive information pertaining to my application and enrolment, via the program application form. Beyond this, I understand that the In2Uni Program will abide by [UOW's Privacy Policy](#).

I understand that if my application is successful, I will need to re-authorise my parents (post-enrolment) to have access to all information pertaining to my enrolment, via the 'Authorisation Form' on the Student Online Learning System (SOLS).

4. Program Attendance Requirements

I understand that in order to **successfully complete** the University Preparation Program, I will be must maintain an 80% attendance rate throughout the program. I understand that this includes a minimum of 24 hours tutoring/study sessions (with attendance at Mock Exam or Mock Interview days countable towards this balance only for Batemans Bay, Bega, Shoalhaven, Southern Highlands and South Western Sydney Campuses) . I understand that I may apply for Special Consideration, as per UOW's [Student Academic Consideration Policy](#), if extenuating circumstances exist that mean I cannot meet this minimum attendance, I understand that holiday arrangements and Trial Examination/School commitments will not be considered under this policy.

5. Eligibility for a Guaranteed Admissions Interview

I understand that by **successfully completing** the University Preparation Program, I will be eligible to receive a guaranteed Admissions Interview with one UOW faculty.

This interview will be for a degree determined by UOW, dependant on my academic performance, and may not be for the course I listed in my Admissions application.

I further understand that if I am not meeting the published indicative criteria for course I apply to I may be offered an admissions interview to a UOW Pathways Program in lieu of an admissions interview to a UOW degree. To be eligible for this interview I must:

- Follow any Admissions Program application procedure when applications open in 2018, and meet any published UOW Admissions criteria for general applications, including but not limited:
 - a. Being a Year 12 student completing the HSC, interstate equivalent or International Baccalaureate in 2018
 - b. Be eligible for an ATAR or successful award of the IB Diploma^
 - c. Be studying at an Australian High School (in Australia)
 - d. Be under 21 years of age#

I therefore understand that I will not receive a guaranteed Admission interview if I am a mature age students (over 21 years of age), off-shore international student or non-school leaver.
