



WUSA ANNUAL GENERAL ELECTION

In accordance with Section 4.6 of the Constitution of the University of Wollongong Undergraduate Students' Association (WUSA), and the WUSA Regulations Governing Elections, the Annual General Elections of WUSA shall be held by way of online election from:

9am Tuesday, 16 October 2018 until 5pm Thursday, 18 October 2018

Voting will be conducted on-line through SOLS. Access to online voting will be available continuously from 9am Tuesday, 16 October 2018 until 5pm Thursday, 18 October 2018. Voters will be able to seek assistance from a Help Service during business hours (9am till 5pm) on the days on which voting is open.

In accordance with Section 4.3 of the WUSA Constitution, the following positions shall be elected by and from the eligible undergraduate students of the University at the Annual General Election. Section 4.6.6 of the Constitution details the qualifications required for specific positions. The following positions are to be contested at the 2018 election:

Making a Nomination

In accordance with Section 4.1 of the WUSA Regulations Governing Election, **nominations will open at midday, 12pm on Monday, 10 September 2018.**

To be a candidate in the WUSA Annual General Elections, you must be an enrolled undergraduate student at the University of Wollongong and must satisfy the criteria of undergraduate student as per Part 4 Section 13 of the University of Wollongong By-law (2005).



The persons qualified to be elected are those whose names appear on the Roll of Undergraduate Students at the time of the opening of nominations. The Roll of Undergraduate Students consists of all persons who are enrolled as candidates proceeding towards an undergraduate degree, diploma or certificate in the University. **This is with the exception of discrete honours program students**, who are eligible to participate in the WUPA Annual General Election.

Nominations will close at midday, 12pm on Friday 21 September 2018.

Nominations must be made in writing using the Nomination Form. Nomination Forms will be available online from: <http://www.uow.edu.au/governance/elections/index.html>. The Nomination Form must be signed by a proposer and a seconder whose names also appear on the Roll of Undergraduate Students at the time of the opening of nominations. Candidate Statements and photographs may accompany the nomination but must be in the format detailed on the Nomination Form.

Nominations, Candidate Statements and photographs are to be lodged with the Returning Officer via email to uow-elections@uow.edu.au no later than the time and date for the close of nominations (**midday, 12pm on Friday 21 September 2018**). This applies for individual nominations as well as for the option of completing registration of a Group Ticket.
