

Graduate Certificate Health Research



COMMENCES AUTUMN 2018

This course, targets clinicians and health professionals who wish to update their skills in health research and boost their career prospects.

The distinctive feature of this program is that it can be taken as either 6 months full time or 1 year part time through flexible teaching methods which will include face-to-face teaching and distance learning modes.

- The Graduate Certificate of Health Research is comprised of 24cp of research training and coursework subjects
- Students complete two compulsory subjects and two electives in quantitative and qualitative research methods and also research ethics and integrity
- International candidates can undertake the program in their home country via distance learning mode.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to apply for the Graduate Certificate of Health Research applicants will need to:

- Hold an Undergraduate degree or equivalent
- English language requirements IELTS 6.5 (bands 6.0 or greater)

COST

- Domestic students \$11,500
- International students \$14,000
- For Australian citizens FEE-HELP is available

WHEN DOES THE COURSE RUN

This Graduate Certificate runs in line with standard University sessions

- Autumn session: March to June
- Spring session: July to November

FURTHER STUDY OPTIONS

After completion of the Graduate Certificate of Health Research students may be eligible to enrol in a UOW Masters of Research or Master of Philosophy and progress to a Doctoral Degree.
